


#### DEAR FRIENDS & FAMILY.



# The Nation of Guatemala

We love Guatemala! And we believe that God has Operation Jabez in this country on purpose to fulfill the Great Commission (Matthew 28:19-20).

Here are some *highlights* about this beautiful nation that we call home.

Join us in *prayer* for Guatemala and the individual lives that we encounter every day. <u>Pray that Christ will be made known!</u>



#### **EDUCATION**

The average drop-out age is 11 years old for boys and 10 years old for girls. Many children cannot finish school because they have to stay home, work, and help to provide for their families.



#### **ECONOMY**

Despite low unemployment rates (about 3%), roughly 60% of the population lives below the poverty line, and 20% of the population holds over 51% of the total nation's wealth.



#### **PEOPLE**



There are about 15 million people in Guatemala, making it the most populous country in Central America. Over 55% of the population is under the age of 25, 34% are from ages 25–34, 5% are from ages 55–64, and approximately 5% are age 65 and up.

#### **SPIRITUALITY**



Catholicism is the dominate religion, though the evangelical Church has seen tremendous growth over the past century. Guatemalans are open to God. However, it is important for missionaries to present the Gospel of grace through Jesus Christ, not of works or reflecting indigenous spirituality.

### **MAJOR ISSUES**



Major issues throughout Guatemala include: high crime rates, low literacy rates, corruption, gang violence, drugs, prejudice toward the indigenous population, child labor, hunger, extreme poverty, and the list goes on...


## Construction is moving forward! The Lord is providing!

"About the first part, 'Bless me'... Just the fact that you have the nerve to ask the Lord for more blessings and then find out that He is willing to pour out more... That to me was a revelation.

My territory in Guatemala, I thought was small and limited.
I wanted something that was going to be country-wide, reaching
Guatemalans... So, the second part, 'enlarge my territory' means 'enlarge my
influence here.' It means, 'Let me go beyond the boundaries to know and
teach the people of Guatemala, so that they can teach others.'

Mostly that is what it has meant to me."

And do you know what? God is doing it! God is answering the prayers that Carol prayed years ago to begin Operation Jabez, and He is *still* faithfully answering our prayers today!
